Troy Clarke

Troy A. Clarke assumed the role of Navistar Inc.'s President and Chief Executive Officer on April 15, 2013, after serving as the company's Chief Operating Officer since August 2012. Previously, he was President, Truck and Engine, since July 2012. Clarke joined the company in December 2010 as President of Navistar Asia Pacific. He came to Navistar after a distinguished 35-year career at General Motors.

North America and GM Group Vice President. Preceding that role, he spent two years as the President of GM Asia Pacific and GM Group Vice President. Clarke also held the role of GM Group Vice President of Manufacturing and Labor Relations. Over the course of his career with GM, he held several additional leadership roles, including President and Managing Director of GM de Mexico and Director of Manufacturing for GM de Mexico.

Clarke joined GM in 1973 as a co-op student at Pontiac Motor Division. He remained at Pontiac for 10 years, holding several engineering and manufacturing roles of increasing responsibility. He received a bachelor's degree in engineering from the General Motors Institute (now Kettering University) and a master's degree in business administration from the University of Michigan. Clarke has served on the board of directors of Fuel Systems Solutions, Inc. since December 2011.



Walter Borst

Walter Borst is Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of Navistar International Corporation. He joined Navistar in August 2013. He is also Chairman of Navistar Financial Corporation, the company's global financing arm.

Borst came to Navistar from General Motors, where he most recently was the Chairman, Chief Executive Officer and President of GM Asset Management since 2010. Previously, Borst was Vice President and Treasurer at GM from 2003 to 2010. He also served as CFO of Adam Opel AG in Ruesselsheim, Germany. Prior to that time, he held roles in various treasury, controller and financial operating capacities at GM over a distinguished 33-year career there.

Borst has a bachelor's degree in industrial administration from General Motors Institute (now Kettering University) and a master's degree in business administration from Stanford University.

Bill Kozek

William R. Kozek was named President, Truck and Parts of Navistar, Inc., in November 2014. Prior to that, he served as the company's President of North America Truck and Parts.

Before joining Navistar in 2013, Kozek served as Vice President and General Manager of PACCAR's Peterbilt division. He also served as Vice President of PACCAR China, and before that, he was Vice President and General Manager of PACCAR's Kenworth division.

Kozek began his career as an accountant for Peterbilt in 1987, and served in a number of finance roles before moving into operations as a Parts District Manager for the Kenworth division in 1995. He spent the next 16 years at Kenworth progressing through a number of key operational roles.

Kozek is a graduate of Miami University of Ohio and has an MBA from St. Mary's College in California. He also attended Stanford's Executive Program in 2008.

Persio V. Lisboa has served as President, Operations, for Navistar, Inc., since November 2014. Prior to that position, he was the company's Senior Vice President and Chief Procurement Officer.

Lisboa joined the company in 1988 as a member of the marketing team of Maxion International Motores Brasil, which later became MWM International Motores, Navistar's South American engine subsidiary. During his tenure in South America, he held various leadership roles of increasing responsibility, including President of the company's engine subsidiary in Argentina and Vice President of Sales and Marketing for MWM.

After that, he became Vice President and General Manager of the inline engine business unit of Navistar's Engine Group. From there, he went on to serve as Vice President of Purchasing and Logistics for the Engine Group before being named Navistar's Chief Procurement Officer.

Dennis "Denny" Mooney serves as Senior Vice President, Global Product Development for Navistar. He joined the company in 2010 as Vice President, Global Engineering.

Prior to Navistar, Mooney had a distinguished 31-year career with General Motors, where he most recently served as Vice President of Global Vehicle Engineering. He also served as chairman and managing director of General Motors (GM) Holden in Australia. Mooney was responsible for GM's Asia Pacific engineering operations in China, Korea, India and Thailand, and Isuzu truck sales in Australia and New Zealand.
